## SCOTCH WHISKY

Whisky must be aged in oak barrels for at least three years. Any age statement on a bottle of Scotch whisky, expressed in numerical form, must reflect the age of the youngest whisky used to produce that product. A whisky with an age statement is known as guaranteed-age whisky.

## SINGLE MALT WHISKY

Must be made exclusively from malted barley (although the addition of caramel coloring is allowed), must be distilled using a pot still, and must be aged for at least three years in oak casks.

## AMERICAN & RYE WHISKY

Must be distilled to not more than 80% alcohol by volume (160 proof) to ensure that the flavor of the original mash is adequately retained, and the addition of coloring, caramel and flavoring additives is prohibited.

## IRISH WHISKY

Must be distilled and aged in the Republic of Ireland or in Ireland. The contained spirits must be distilled to an alcohol by volume level of less than 94.8% from a yeast-fermented mash of cereal grains.

## VODKA

Is a diminutive form of the Slavic word voda (water), interpreted as little water. The word "vodka" was recorded for the first time in 1405.

## RUM

Is a distilled alcoholic beverage made from sugarcane byproducts such as molasses, or directly from sugarcane juice, by a process of fermentation and distillation. The word can be referred to in Spanish by descriptors such as ron viejo ("old rum") and ron añejo ("aged rum").
